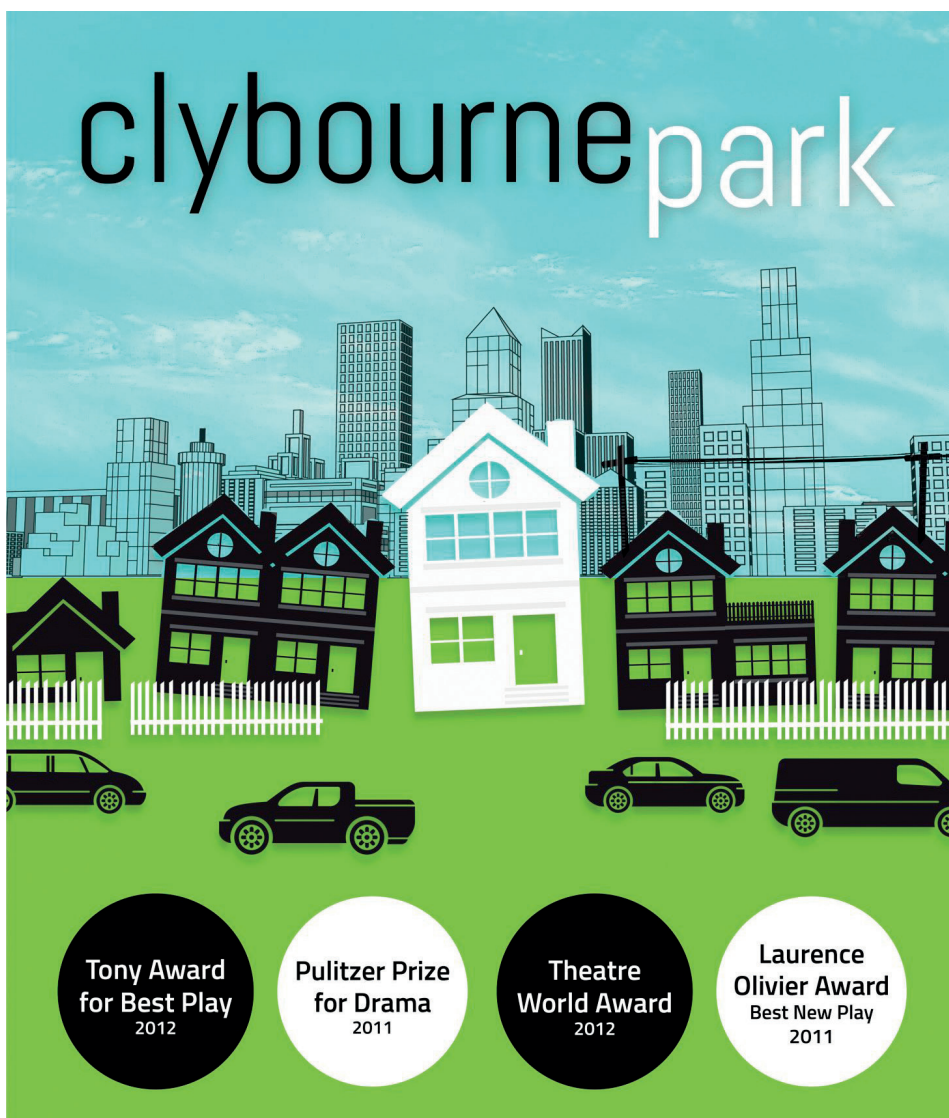
In 1959, a grieving family are
