Cleaning will include wiping down chairs and tables used, and any high-touch points such as door handles and light switches. Room capacity and masks to be worn in the changing rooms. Toilets to be cleaned regularly, and signage will be in place to inform users on keeping the area clean. Common room kitchen to be open, however with a maximum capacity limit.
