I worked closely with a professional designer and director to realise their elaborate and ambitious designs. To this end I sourced garments from Bristol Costume Services, collaborating with multiple departments to arrange and run actor fittings, and supervised the making of other costumes, liaising with makers and buying fabric. I kept track of the costume budget and all receipts, and oversaw the alterations done by the costume assistants. I also created plots for dressing and laundry. In addition I experimented extensively to find a non-toxic, non-staining, striking-looking "blood" for a key scene, and dyed around 40 metres of fabric for kilts.

Dresser for Priscilla, Queen of the Desert at Bath Theatre Royal (July 2021)

I joined the costume crew for two performances of a professional touring musical, dressing (including quick changes) and sorting chorus costumes backstage in an extremely fast-paced environment. Aided Wardrobe Department with show laundry.

Costume assistant/ dresser for BOVTS' Hedda, Far From the Madding Crowd, and Troilus & Cressida (2020-2021)

I aided the costume supervisors in fittings and contributed to sourcing garments from shops and Bristol Costume Services, making alterations, and some show makes (flat cap, bustle, double-breasted waistcoat). Did hairdressing on FFTMC and did multiple quick-changes backstage throughout the show.
